CLIMATE FORUM THIS SATURDAY 14TH OCTOBER:

This will be held at 11 am (coffee at 10.30 am) in Room 3b on the top floor of Barnstaple Library. The focus will be on the Climate and Ecology Bill which Caroline Lucas is re-introducing into Parliament on November 24 th (three years after the first time). Especially with the Conservatives trashing the attempts to reduce carbon, this is a vital bill.
